3. His Word
  - a. Authority
  - b. Power

**OUR RESPONSE**

*Let the word of Christ dwell richly in you, in all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another (Colossians 3:16)*

1. The word of Christ
  - a. That which He spoke
  - b. That which He taught
  - c. They are recorded for us in the Scriptures
2. Dwell richly in you
  - a. Dwell: to live in; to inhabit

*Cf. Deuteronomy 6:8-9*

    - i. God's Word was placed in the home: constantly taught, reviewed and remembered
    - ii. God's Word was meant to be closely involved in every part of our lives
  - b. Richly
    - i. Abundance
    - ii. With no lack
  - c. In you
    - i. A deep part of us
    - ii. Affecting all that we do and say
3. In all wisdom

- a. Wisdom is needed
    - i. To understand
    - ii. To apply
  - b. It is to be prayed for
4. Teaching and admonishing one another
- a. Two aspects about the Word of Christ is highlighted
  - b. It teaches us
  - c. It admonishes us
    - i. Warns
    - ii. Corrects
