## A TEST OF FAITH

- 1. The kind of test
  - a. Surprise test
  - b. Challenging test
    - i. Some of the disciples were fishermen
    - ii. But this challenge tested them beyond what they could handle
- 2. Reasons for allowing for a test of faith
  - a. Affirm strengths
  - b. Uncover weaknesses

## **RESULTS OF THE TEST OF FAITH**

- 1. Fear (Luke 8: 24)
- 2. No faith (little faith) (Luke 8: 25, Mark 4: 40)
- 3. Deeper underlying reason: Hardness of heart
  - a. A second test in Mark 6: 45 52 Similar results
  - b. Problems revealed (Mark 6: 52)
    - i. "They had not understood"
    - ii. "Because their heart was hardened"
  - c. Meaning
    - i. It has been hardened from the beginning
    - ii. It remains hardened (perfect tense)

  - b. Yet you may not be learning much
- 2. Return
  - a. To God

- b. To His Word
- 3. Revival
  - a. Coming alive to God
